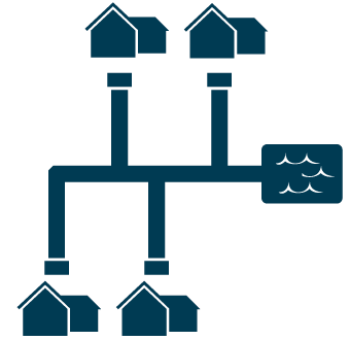

FULL REGULATORY
PROCESS



FILE NOTICE OF INTENT
Union County submits a Notice of Intent to file a petition.



PUBLIC NOTICE
A written notice shall be provided at least 30 days before the public meetings are held for the notice of intent.



PUBLIC MEETINGS
The applicant shall hold 3+ public meetings within 90 days of filing the notice of intent. Meetings shall be held at a public location and shall be open to the public. Meetings shall be held at least 10 days after the last meeting.



SUBMIT DRAFT EIS
Union County develops and submits a Draft EIS to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the Department of Water Resources (DWR).

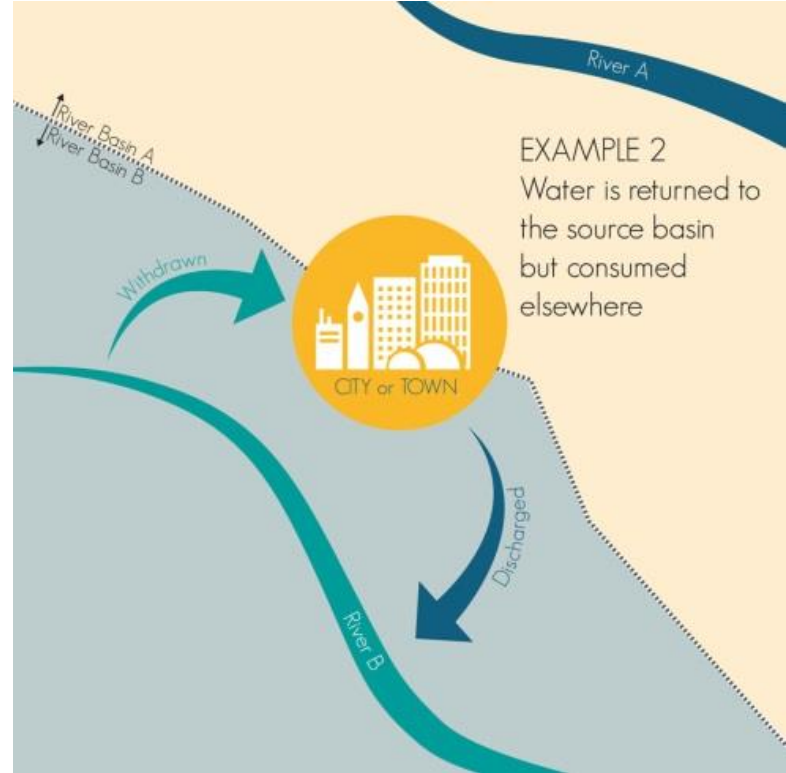
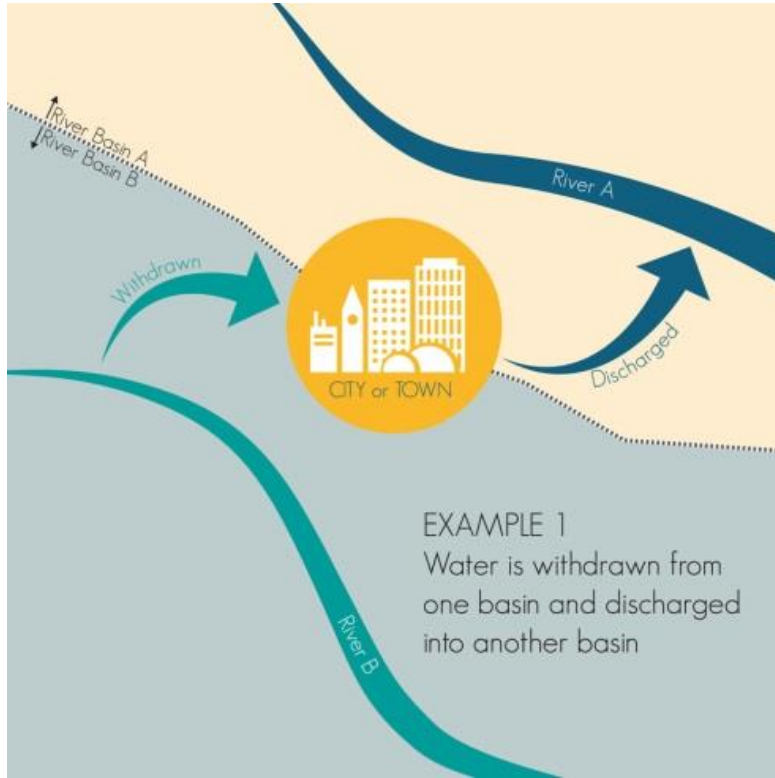


RECORD OF DECISION
The Environmental Management Commission (EMC)/Division of Water Resources (DWR) issues a record of decision on the Draft EIS.



SUBMIT INTERBASIN TRANSFER PETITION
Union County submits a petition to the EMC for an interbasin transfer.

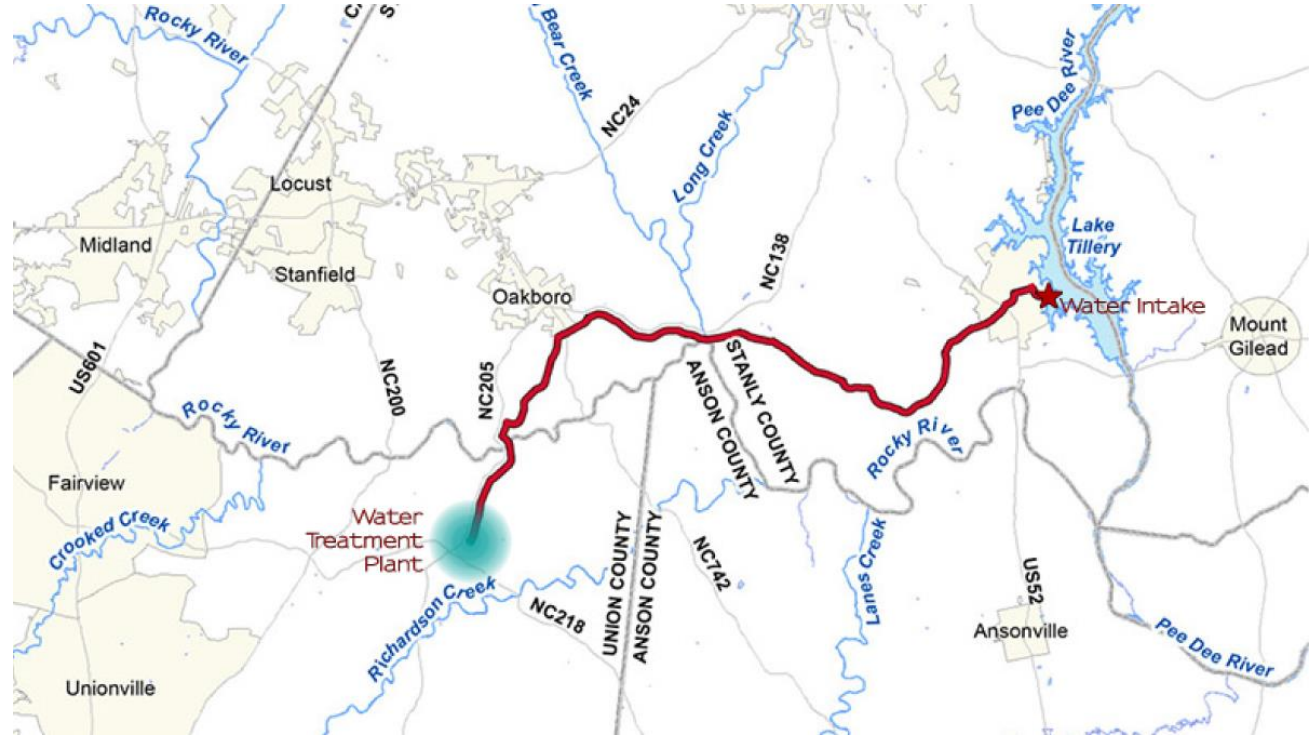
Preferred Alternative

Impacts of Preferred Alternative



WATER SUPPLY

Alternative 1A can supply the 28.9 mgd needed for current and future needs.



COST

Alternative 1A represents one of the lowest cost alternatives and is a financially feasible option for this water supply.



LAKE IMPACTS

Alternative 1A has less impact on lake aesthetics, other water needs, and hydropower than the other alternatives evaluated.



ENVIRONMENTAL

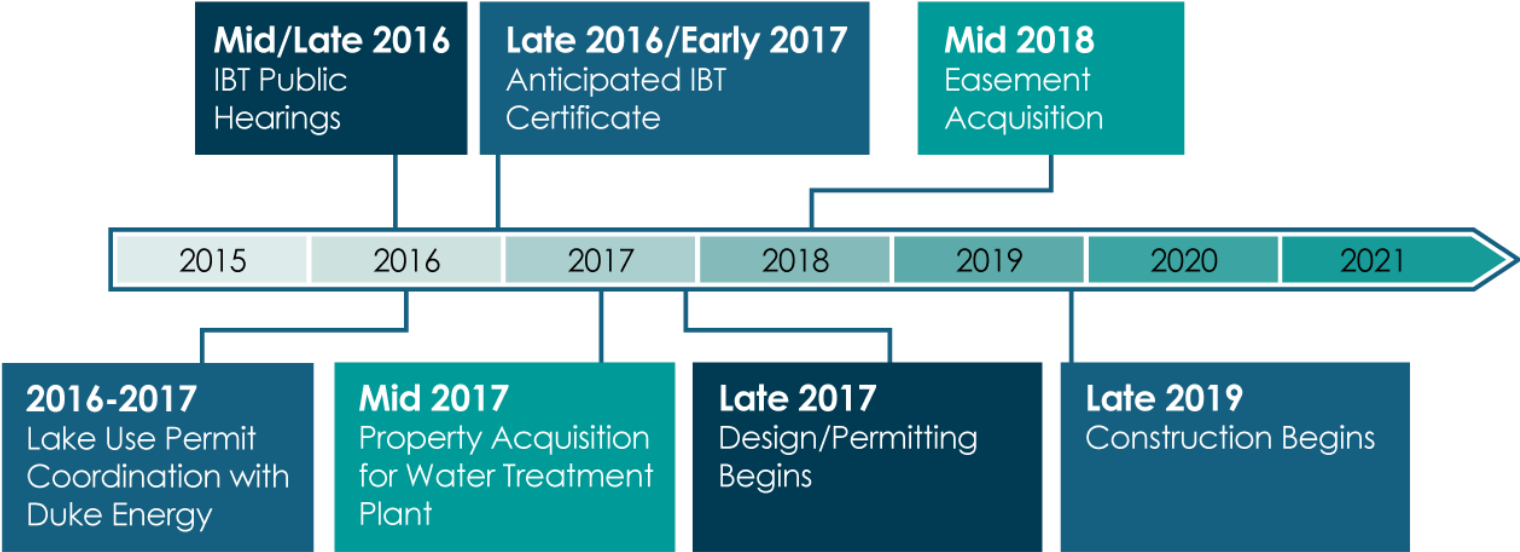
The environmental impacts of Alternative 1A are similar, or significantly less, than the other alternatives evaluated.



COMMUNITY

The water supply partnership between the Town of Norwood and Union County makes 1A the most politically acceptable alternative.

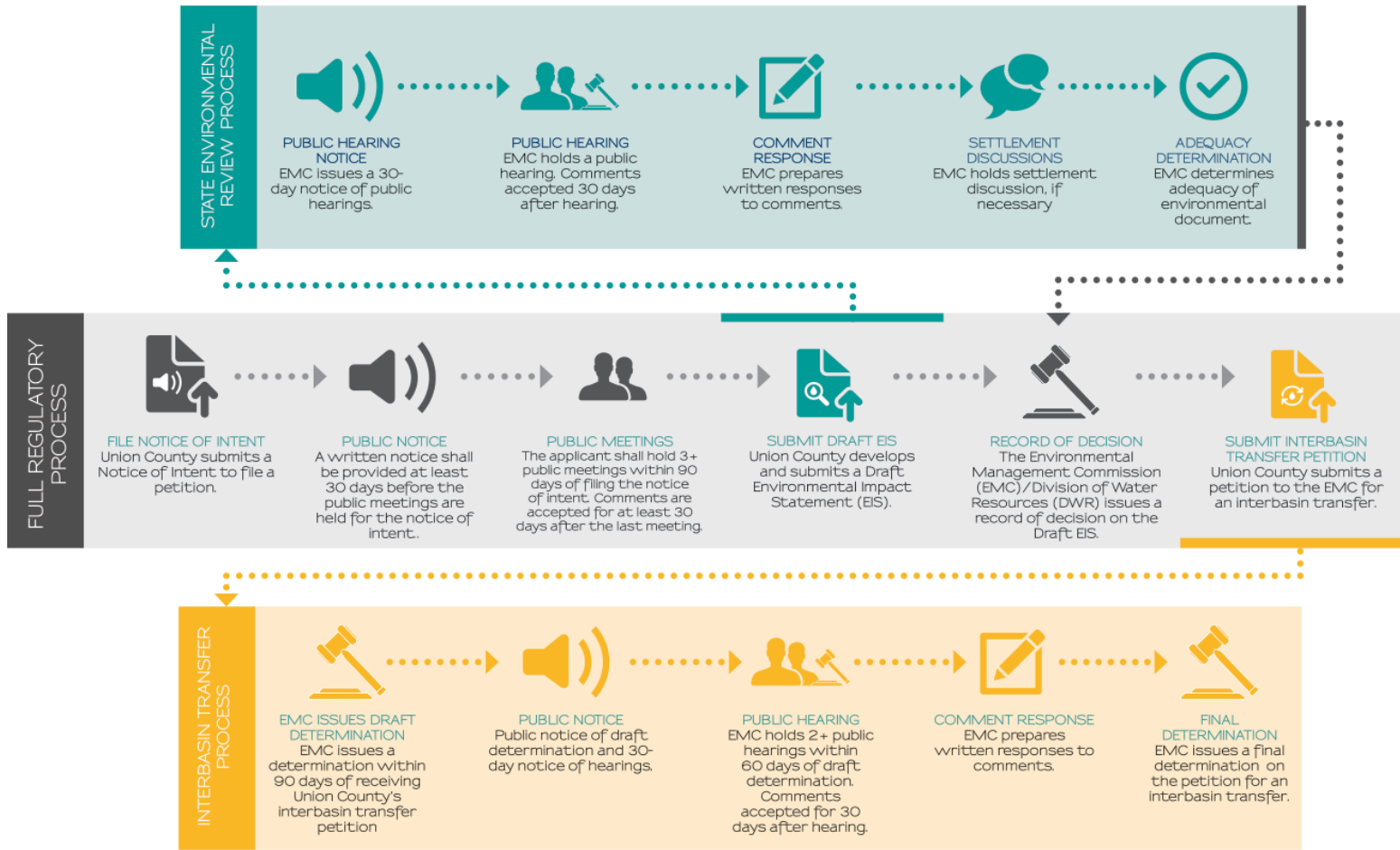
